Question 2: How many things are necessary for thee to know, that thou, enjoying this comfort, mayest live and die happily?	
Answer: Three; the first, how great my sins and miseries are; the second, how I may be delivered from all my sins and miseries; the third, how I shall express my gratitude to God for such deliverance.
