#### Sermon

Question 4: What does God's law require of us? Answer: Christ teaches us this in a summary in Matthew 22: You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it, You shall love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the law and the prophets.

Question 5: Can you keep all this perfectly? Answer: No, I am inclined by nature to hate God and my neighbour.

Question 6: Did God, then, create man so wicked and perverse? Answer: No, on the contrary, God created man good and in His image, that is, in true righteousness and holiness, so that he might rightly know God His Creator, heartily love Him, and live with Him in eternal blessedness to praise and glorify Him.

Question7: From where, then, did man's depraved nature come? Answer: From the fall and disobedience of our first parents, Adam and Eve, in Paradise, for there our nature became so corrupt that we are all conceived and born in sin.

Question 8: But are we so corrupt that we are totally unable to do any good and inclined to all evil?

Answer: Yes, unless we are regenerated by the Spirit of God.
